Dress code

Your etiquette on the course and in the Clubhouse are more important to us than telling someone how to dress. Please see our guidelines on dress code on the course and in the Clubhouse.



On the Course:

- ➤ The guideline is that any recognised golfing apparel that can be purchased from a professional retail outlet is acceptable.
- No Football, Gaelic or Rugby tops or shorts.
- > No denims on the course.

In the Clubhouse:

- ➤ Any smart casual clothing. Including smart denim is acceptable in the Clubhouse.
- ➤ Smart shirts designed to be worn outside trousers, short or skirts and modern casual shoes including smart trainers, sandals, loafers and deck shoes are permitted.
- ➤ Any type of footwear and hats worn on the course are not acceptable in the Clubhouse.
- No Football, Gaelic or Rugby tops or shorts are allowed in the Clubhouse. *With the exception of affiliated sports club meeting in the Clubhouse.
